

WHITEHORSE CO-ED SLO-PITCH
REGISTRATION RULES 2011 (league@whsecoed.ca)

- 1} A Team sponsorship fee of \$350.00 per team, is due by the April meeting. A grace period of 2 weeks may be extended to early May, upon request from teams in good standing.
- 2} Also required before the season starts, is a \$50.00 performance bond, which will be returned at the end of the season if the team is in good standing.
- 3} Players fees of \$ 90.00 are to be made payable to **Co-Ed Slo-pitch League**, not Softball Yukon. Cash or Cheque only (No Visa). Player fees are due by Mon. May 02, 2011 (5:00 pm to 8:00 pm) at Sport Yukon. A minimum of 12 players (6 male & 6 female) must be signed up and paid. (A minimum of 16 players is preferred). A reduced fee of \$ 60.00 will apply to Younger players from 16 to 18 years of age.
- 4} After May 8, all players must pay in full, in order to play in any game.
- 5} A reduced fee of \$60.00 will be allowed for players wishing to join in the second half (Starting June 20, 2011). A reduced fee will be accepted from players only playing the first half.
- 6} If a player issues an N.S.F. cheque, that player is suspended until fees are paid in full, or other arrangements are made with league executive.
- 7} Refunds of registration fees will be at the discretion of the Co-Ed Executive. A player who quits will not be entitled to any refund of fees. (A transfer of funds, or refund for pregnancy, will be considered).
- 8} Team Registration forms must be completed in Full.
- 9} Minimum age to play is 16. That is, a player who is 15 can play if his/her 16th birthday is before Dec. 31, 2011. A younger player will be considered, only by a written request to the Co-Ed Executive.
- 10} SPN (Slo-Pitch National) recommended softballs will be used. (Softballs and Score-books will be supplied when Team registration fees are paid). Teams are requested not to mark up the Balls.
- 11} Teams using illegal or unregistered players will default the game. The umpire and the opposing team shall be notified of the protest before the game ends. If a team is unsure of a players eligibility and discovers he/she is illegal after the game, the executive has the power to make a decision regarding that game. For further clarification on any other questions refer to the SPN rule book. The protest must be e-mailed in no later than 9:00 am the next day. The written protest must be provided to the Executive, within a few days.
- 12} Players may only change teams during the regular season. Any player changing teams must let the league Executive know, before they play their first game for their new team. A player may switch to a new team, only once during the season. A 2nd change of teams, will result in extra Fees to be paid. Any changes must be made a minimum of one week before the closing tourney.
