

Tournament Rules

- 1) Any registered players with Softball Yukon may play on any team in Whitehorse Co-Ed tournaments, subject to the following rules.
- 2) A Whse Co-Ed Lg Player may play in any division in either tournament only if they are registered and paid in both divisions. Registration must be done during the regular season.
- 3) An unregistered player must be listed on the Roster, at the coaches meeting that will be held the week before the tournament starts. There will be a \$30.00 fee due before they play, and they must sign the Roster form. That player may only play in that tournament, unless the remaining regular season fees are paid. Only 1 Male and 1 Female can be added by using this method.
- 4) One substitute Co-Ed player with Softball Yukon, of each sex, can be picked up to fill a roster. These players cannot be from a team that is playing in that tourney, unless they are registered and paid to play on 2 separate teams, in different divisions, before the tourney starts. A Maximum of 3 X-over players is now in effect for the season and the tourney. No extra Cross-over players can be added, if a team is carrying the maximum of 3.
- 5) There will be a mandatory Coaches meeting held, one week before the tournament start date at 6:00 PM at the Pepsi Complex. Final rosters are due at this time, and changes will only be allowed to midnight that evening. No players will be allowed to be picked up after the roster is Frozen. **IF YOU DO NOT SHOW FOR THE MEETING YOUR TEAM WILL NOT BE IN THE TOURNAMENT**, unless notified by e-mail. Schedules and a summary of team rosters will be posted and circulated, 2 to 3 days before the tourney starts, if possible.
- 6) All other “Regular Season” league rules & SPN rules will be used, except for rule 3 (Refer to Season Rules – Rule 3). No Players can be picked up if you cannot field a team. Only the roster submitted, may be used for the entire tourney.
- 7) Any team caught using illegal players in a tournament, will lose that game, and will be removed from that tourney without compensation.
- 8) No inning will start 15 minutes before end of game time unless tied. Tie breaker rules are to follow the SPN (Slo-Pitch National) rule book Tie breakers will start at the beginning of the eighth inning or earlier if the time limit has expired.
- 9) The Home team will be decided by a Coin Toss for all games except the Final. The undefeated team that makes it to the Final, of any Whse CoEd Lg tourney, will be declared the home team for that Final game. There is now only a 1 game final in all Whse CoEd tourneys (similar to Dustball), and there is no Time Limit on the Final game.
